
To Whom it May Concern:

The productions you put on with the youth have been terrific. They not only provide our entire student body with a great artistic experience but they learn from those experiences as well.


We appreciate how you use the arts to teach our young people many valuable life lessons including the importance and power of their choices and how they affect their lives.
